Members will elect new Governing Board Members and we will discuss and vote on a 2019-2020 budget.

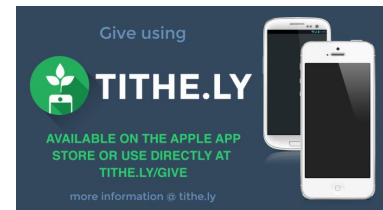
Childcare will be provided for ages preschool - 5th grade.
